



# PAINTED PLANT POTS

## *What you need*

- Terracotta plant pots
- Acrylic paint
- Paintbrushes
- Water cup
- Plants of your choice
- Soil (+ water to water plants after repotting)

## METHOD:

1. Prepare your terracotta pot with a damp cloth to remove any dust.
2. Choose a base colour for your pot (like light blue or pink).
3. Dip your large paintbrush into the paint and cover the outside of the pot with the base colour. Let the paint dry for about 30 minutes. You can paint a second coat if needed for a brighter colour.
4. Dip a smaller brush into red paint. Paint small, oval shapes all around the pot to make strawberries. These can be about the size of your thumb. Let the red paint dry for a few minutes.
5. Use a small brush to add little green leaves at the top of each strawberry.
6. Use a small brush and yellow paint in small dots to create the centre of the daisies, then use a small brush and white paint to create daisy petals. Allow all your painted designs to dry completely.
7. Once the paint is dry, fill the pot with soil, leaving about an inch of space at the top. Plant your small plants in the soil. Press them down gently. Add more soil if needed to cover the roots of your plants.
8. Gently water your plants with a watering can or cup. Make sure the soil is moist but not too wet.
9. Place your pot in a sunny spot and water them regularly.
